PLEASE READ ALL WARNINGS BEFORE SETTING UP YOUR SUPER-BRELLA

STANDARD SUPER-BRELLA CONFIGURATION:

STEP 1: Open the Super-Brella like an umbrella. Slide the Super-Brella up until it clicks into place. Place on the ground so the red button on the pole faces forward.

STEP 2: Unclip both slide flaps so they hang down to the ground.

STEP 3: Release extension pole. [WARNING: The extension pole is inside the main pole and has a pointed end. Please loosen the knob slowly to release the extension pole.] Pull the extension pole out 10 to 12 inches and tighten the knob to secure.

STEP 4: Make sure the Super-Brella is in the proper location for maximum weather protection and viewing angles before staking it into the ground. While holding the extension pole and main pole, stake the Super-Brella into the ground 3-4 inches, so the side flaps hang just above the ground.

STEP 5: Using 4 Standard Ground Stakes (the smaller, thinner ones), stake the front 4 grommets at the bottom of the Super-Brella into the ground. [NOTE: For looser ground, such as sand, it is recommended that you use the Heavy-Duty Ground Stakes for more stability.] If conditions are breezy you can stake in the back of the Super-Brella as well by combining the Heavy-Duty Ground Stakes and Standard Ground Stakes.

TIP: If conditions are windy, use 2 Anchor Cords with the Heavy-Duty Ground Stakes for extra wind security. [NOTE: The Super-Brella is not recommended for extreme wind conditions.]

Clip the Anchor Cord to one of the top D-rings on the Super-Brella. Stake the cord into the ground and cinch the yellow integrated adjustment clip to remove any slack from the cord. Repeat the same procedure with the second cord. Use extra cord in the back for added stability.


- TIP: The Super-Brella windows have been engineered to improve visibility and air flow. To open the windows, simply unzip them, roll them down and tie them down to secure. You can also open halfway and tuck the flap inside to secure. In windy conditions, open the windows to allow for more air flow through the Super-Brella.
- TIP: Side pockets can be used to store additional belongings. When full, pockets provide added support for windier conditions. Pockets can be easily filled with heavy objects or even sand for extra weight.











CONVENTIONAL UMBRELLA CONFIGURATION:

STEP 1: Open the Super-Brella. Keep the side flaps clipped up.

STEP 2: Release the extension pole out approximately 2 feet and tighten knob. While holding the extension pole, push the stake straight into the ground at least 8 inches, keeping the pole perpendicular to the ground.

STEP 3: Secure with all 3 anchor cords, 2 in front and 1 in back.

TIP: For extra-wide protection, you can unclip the side flaps and secure with all 3 anchor cords, 2 on extended side flaps and 1 anchor cord in the back.

PACKING UP THE SUPER-BRELLA:

Make sure Super-Brella is dry before packing in bag.

STEP 1: Remove any ground stakes and anchor cords and store in pouch, zip up windows and reclip the side flaps to the Super-Brella.

STEP 2: Loosen the pole knob, slide the extension pole fully into the main pole and retighten the knob securely so the extension pole cannot slide out.

STEP 3: Close the Super-Brella like an umbrella. Push in the red button and slide the Super-Brella down. Locate the tie down cord and twist the Super-Brella up as tight as possible and Velcro the tie down around the umbrella. Place back into bag along with the small pouch of components.
